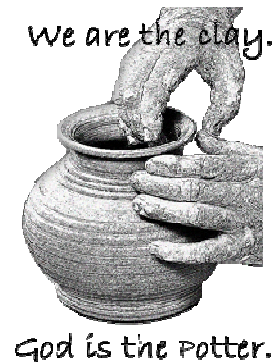

A WORD FROM WALT

David Tucker brought his potter's wheel to Inner City Ministry Monday night. For at least a half hour he captured the attention of more than fifty highly energetic boys and girls as he skillfully and carefully shaped a large piece of clay into a beautifully crafted vase.

For several weeks, these children have been reminded, as have we, of the familiar words from Isaiah 64 – "We are the clay, God is the potter."

They intently watched David shape the clay as he reminded them of some of the same important truths he had taught us just a few weeks ago – on the first Sunday morning in January.

For example, in order for the potter to be able to shape the clay effectively –

He must first know what he ultimately wants the clay to become – *and God, the Master Potter, knows what He wants each of us to become.*

The attention of the potter must be focused on the clay – *and the eyes of God are focused on us.*

The clay must be centered on the wheel – *and we must be centered in God's will.*

Any foreign objects in the clay (sticks, rocks, etc.) must be removed – *and any foreign objects (ungodly habits, attitudes, etc.) must be removed from our lives.*

The clay must be "opened up" to allow the hands of the potter to work from both the inside and the outside – *and our lives must be "opened up" to allow God to work on us from the inside, as well as from the outside.*

After the beautiful vase was finished, only a few were still in the room to witness what may have been one of the most important lessons on the entire night. The vase was sitting on the wheel, but David had stepped away to answer questions from some of the inquisitive children. Someone passing by the potter's wheel accidentally hit the foot pedal on the floor – and the wheel quickly accelerated. In less than a second the vase was GONE!

As I watched in amazement, while something so beautiful was innocently yet totally destroyed in just an instant, it reminded me how vital it is for all of us to always be in God's hands!

The chaotic world we live in can accelerate instantly and without warning. We may think we're secure and capable – but without being cradled in the powerful and caring hands of our Master Potter ... we don't have a chance!

Later today we'll have two opportunities to continue our study – **The Fingers on God's Hands: What God Uses to Shape Our Lives.** I am looking forward to worshipping with you at either 3:00 p.m. or 6:00 p.m. Both times will be SUPER!

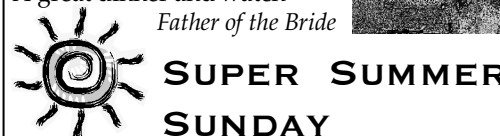

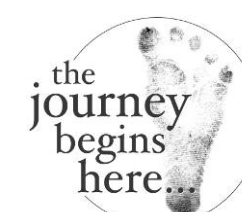
